## CORE VALUE: ZEAL FOR COMMUNITY AND MISSION

**ORDER** : Rise up in splendor! Isaiah 60:1  
Raise your eyes and look about. Isaiah 60:4

*Trust in Me. I will always be there for you to show you the right path.*  
*You are My disciples. Have faith in Me.*  
*I have called you and I will empower you. You will be able to do things that you can ever imagine.*

**2.** Thanking our Father in heaven by sharing our blessings with the poor.  
**3.** Be guided by the Lord as we daily read His word.

### REFLECTION:

*"The Light of Christ, the true light, which enlightens every man, has come into the world." John 1:9*

This New Year let us allow ourselves to be led by the Light of Christ for His Light is not only essential but is indispensable in our walk as disciples and followers of Christ. In this life, we walk through a dark forest of evil, uneven ground with entangling tree roots of false values and beliefs. But the Light of Christ, through His word, can be our light to show the way ahead so we won't stumble as we walk. It will enable us to see clear enough to stay in the right path. *It is the lamp unto our feet* – guiding us to the direction we are to take. (Psalm 119:105)

Darkness is also often associated with fear --- of uncertainty, misunderstanding, rejection even sickness and death.
